

Exam Orientation

1. Buses pick up at the normal times on the way to school. Buses leave at 11:10 a.m. Come to school only if you have an exam to write.
2. Most of the exams are written in the gym. When you come in on the morning of your exam, check the sports bulletin board by the Tuck Shop for the actual location of your exam.
3. Check the same walls to determine the colour of the paper that will cover your exams in the gym. This will tell you where you can sit.
4. One bell will ring at 8:50 a.m. Teachers will then escort you inside the exam room. Make sure you are quiet in the exam room. Opening devotions will be done in the exam room but you do not have to bring your Bible or Book of Praise.
5. Make sure you bring your semester 1 textbooks to room 104 or 108 on the day of your exam, preferably before the exam begins.
6. You are not to leave your desk at any time. If you need paper or have completed your exam, put up your hand and a supervising teacher will help you.
7. You cannot leave the exam room until about 3/4 of the time for your exam has elapsed. You have a maximum of two hours to complete your exam. That means you cannot leave until 1.5 hours have elapsed.
8. **All normal school rules apply.** Bring drinks in plastic or cardboard containers. The teachers will clear calculators. Leave bags or purses in your locker. **Cell phones, smart watches and any device that could communicate information** may NOT be brought into the exam room. You will be expected to store those in boxes before entering the exam room.
9. Anyone who deliberately disrupts the exam room will be escorted out of the room and receive a zero on the exam.
10. The first day of Semester 2 is Wednesday, January 31st. Lists will be posted in the gym for your 1st period class that day. Updated schedules and textbooks will be distributed that day. If you have any questions about your semester 2 timetable, check with Mr. Leistra.
