Student Services

Before Grade 9...

- ▶ Mr. VanAndel visits each feeder school to advise students regarding course selection.
- ▶ Registration forms submitted to feeder school by early February.

During Grade 9...

- ▶ Mr. VanAndel calls all parents and meets with each student during Semester 1.
- ▶ Course registration forms submitted to Mr. Leistra beginning of Semester 2.

During Grade 10...

- ▶ In the Careers 10 (GLC20) course, investigate career options and specific post-secondary expectations.
- ▶ Introduction to www.careercruising.com.
- ▶ Attend Career Day at Guido.
- ▶ Visit two post-secondary institutions.
- ▶ Course registration forms submitted to Mr. Leistra beginning of Semester 2.
 - ▶ Students can visit Student Services to access post-secondary information.

During Grade 11...

- ▶ Mrs. VanVelzen meets with each student in Semester 1 and again in Semester 2. **Other visits are available upon request.**
- ▶ Computer time will be made available for all students to do Career Cruising (www.careercruising.com).
- ▶ Opportunity to visit one college fair or trade school.
- ▶ Speak to Mrs. VanVelzen to learn how to arrange your own campus visit.
- ▶ Interested in trades? Sign up for Co-op and speak to Mr. Zietsma about potential placements for Grade 12.
- ▶ Monthly emails are sent about career/post-secondary events or job opportunities. **Ensure Mrs. VanVelzen has your email address.**
- ▶ Do research at Career Cruising (www.careercruising.com) and at eINFO (www.electronicinfo.ca).
- ▶ Schedule a visit to Student Services to access post-secondary information before submitting your course registration form.
 - ▶ Course registration forms submitted to Mr. Leistra beginning of Semester 2.

During Grade 12...

- ▶ Mrs. VanVelzen meets twice with each student in the first semester. **Other visits are available upon request.**
- ▶ Attend the session in the computer lab for researching Career Cruising and eINFO.
- ▶ Sign up for college and university liaison visits at our school.
- ▶ A visit is arranged to one college fair.
- ▶ Information about college and university fairs will be made available.
- ▶ A presentation will be made about the apprenticeship process.
- ▶ **Speak to Mrs. VanVelzen to arrange your own first semester campus visit.**
- ▶ **Meet all application deadlines!!** Computer time will be made available for application to college and/or university during the first semester and for financial aid (OSAP) application in late May.
- ▶ A second semester specific campus visit is strongly advised to learn about the program to which you were accepted.
- ▶ Students should visit the scholarship information websites (see Links).
- ▶ Monthly emails are sent about job opportunities or career/post-secondary events. **Ensure Mrs. VanVelzen has your email address.**
- ▶ Students can visit Student Services to access information about post-secondary options.
- ▶ Students who have been accepted to a post-secondary program will meet with Mrs. VanVelzen and possibly alumni to discuss transition to their particular destination.
